HOMELAND SECURITY ID-CARD

1. A **temporary card** is issued at location with information given from the individual; Name, Address, and Date of birth, Social security number, Picture, and a Fingerprint template.
2. All information except the picture is securely stored inside the VSCode® (It's a secured portable data storage container).
3. The VSCode® is printed on the ID-card with the picture of the individual.
4. Only the person with the correct fingerprint can open the data within the VSCode®. This protects the privacy of the individual.
5. VSCode®, with a data capacity of over 4,000 bytes, is stored in a central database and the data can be retrieved or a duplicate ID card can be reproduced. This ID-card is useful only for that individual because the correct fingerprint is the key to open the information.
6. After issuing a temporary card, the information collected at the site along with the VSCode® is verified again by using various databases such as the Police, Social Security, Welfare, Banking institution, Transportation department and others.
7. **Permanent card**- Once the data is verified and the security clearance confirmed, a permanent "Security ID-Card" is issued. This card is not useable by anyone except the person with the fingerprint stored inside the VSCode®.
8. Once the permanent ID-card is issued, the individual relinquishes his or her temporary ID-card. With this card, that individual will have positive identification due to his fingerprint.
9. This secure ID-card allows the person access to the bank, the welfare department, Social Security Office, or anywhere that require a positive ID in order to give the necessary services. This card will eliminate fraud, also can also provide criminal history and protect human right issues.
